- 3. Is a Freedom House Political Rights score of 7 good or bad? Why? What does this score say about the level of political development in each country?
- 4. How is Transparency International's Corruption Perception Index constructed? What is the range of possible scores? How pervasive is corruption in Nigeria compared to the United Kingdom?
- 5. How does the level of women's representation in politics compare across the six countries? What might account for the similarities? The differences?
- 6. How do the six countries compare in terms of the overall democracy index? The subcategories? What factors may explain these similarities? Differences?
- 7. Is high poverty/income inequality correlated with corruption? Do you think one causes the other?
- 8. Is a country's level of economic development correlated with its level of democratization? Consider Mexico and China. Does one cause the other?
